AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HJI MUHAMMAD AJUL, PROVINCE OF BASILAN AND APPRORIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Municipality of Hji. Muhammad Ajul is a coastal area in the Island of Basilan, created by Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act No. 192, ratified on May 22, 2006. Composed of 11 barangays that were formerly part of the Municipality of Tuburan. It has a population of 24, 625 as determined by Population Census in 2020, with a number of 2,948 household, an average of 6.55 members per households.

The Hji. Muhammad Ajul Rural Health Unit is located in barangay Buton as the only facility that brings essential health care services in area that constitutes 5.86 % of Basilan total geography. In case of emergency and other health services, it needs to transport the patient to nearest hospital in neighboring municipality. The difficulty in transporting patients is not only troublesome and trigger excessive anxiety to the family and patients but sometimes causes the loss of lives which directly deprived them of the constitutional right to life which inclusive in the right to health.

Article II, Section 15 of the Philippine Constitution provides that "the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness and in Section 11 of Article 12 states "the state shall adopt health and development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to the people at affordable costs".

Section 22, Article IX of the Republic Act 11054 or otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao states to provide for the comprehensive and integrated health service delivery for its constituents and establish by law and general hospital system to serve the health requirements of its people and ensure that the individual basic right to life shall be attainable through the prompt intervention and excellent and affordable medical services.

Hence, to give substance and spirits to the provision of the Philippine Constitution and the Bangsamoro Organic Law, there is an urgent need for the construction and establishment of Hji. Muhammad

Ajul Municipal Hospital, a measure that provides the Municipal constituents societal rights and ensure their individual basic right to life.

On this premises, immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HJI. MUHAMMAD AJUL PROVINCE OF BASILAN AND APPRORIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Bangsamoro Transition Authority.

**Section 1. Short Title.** This act shall be known as the Hji. Muhammad Ajul Municipal Hospital Act of 2021".

- **Section 2. Declaration** of **Principles and Policies.** It is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of all Filipinos and instill health consciousness among them as stipulated in the Republic Act 11223 The Universal Health Care Law. Towards this end, the State shall adopt:
- (a) An integrated and comprehensive approach to ensure that all Filipinos are health literate, provided with healthy living conditions, and protected from hazards and risks that could affect their health;
- (b) A health care model that provides all Filipinos access to a comprehensive set of quality and cost-effective, promotive, preventive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative health services without causing financial hardship, and prioritizes the needs of the population who cannot afford such services;
- (c) A framework that fosters a whole-of-system, whole-of-government, and whole-of-society approach in the development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of health policies, programs and plans; and
- (d) A people-oriented approach for the delivery of health services that is centered on people's needs and well-being, and cognizant of the differences in culture, values, and beliefs.

It is also the policy of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao to provide for the comprehensive and integrated health service delivery for its constituents and establish by law and general hospital system to serve the health requirements of its people and ensure that the individual basic right to life shall be attainable through the prompt intervention and excellent and affordable medical services of Section 22, Article IX of the Republic Act 11054.

**Section 3. General Objectives.** This act shall seek out better health system delivery and ensure that all Hji. Muhammad Ajul Municipal constituents are guaranteed equitable access to quality and affordable health care and public health facilities. Health services that are devoted primarily to the provision of services for health promotion, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation and palliation of Hji. Muhammad Ajul constituents suffering from illness, disease, injury, disability, or deformity, or when there is immediate danger and where delay in health support that may cause loss of life.

Section 4. Integration of the Universal Health Care (UHC) Program. The Hji Muhammad Ajul Municipal Hospital shall integrate into its system of operation all pertinent and relevant provisions under Republic Act No. 11223 otherwise known as the Universal Health Care Law.

Section 5. Organization and Human Resource System. The Ministry of Health (MOH) with stakeholders, shall ensure the formulation and implementation of a Hji Muhammad Ajul Municipal Health Human Resource Plan that will provide policies and strategies for the appropriate generation, recruitment, training, regulation, assessment of health workforce based on population health needs. The MOH and if necessary with the Provincial Health Boards shall administrative and technical supervision over health facilities and health human resources of the Hji. Muhammad Ajul Hospital which shall include the creation of Municipal Hospital Health Board, defining its power and function and the appointment of the officers and members thereof.

**Section 6.** Appropriations for Construction and Administrative Expenses. The Bangsamoro Autonomous Region, Office of the Chief Minister together with the Ministry of Finance, Budget and Management and the Ministry of Health shall appropriate for the funding of Hji. Muhammad Ajul Hospital Construction including the acquisition of medical and office equipment and the budget needed for personal services, maintenance, operation and other expenses for the impelementation of this Act.

Section 7. Safety and Quality. The MOH shall institute a licensing and regulatory system for stand-alone health facilities, including those providing ambulatory and primary care services, and other modes of health services provisions. It shall set standard for health care provider and health care facilities accessible for the people of Hji. Muhammad Ajul Municipality. It shall also coordinate with the Basilan Electric Company (BASELCO) for the proper procedures and maintenance of its Electricity.

Section 8. Implementing Rules and regulation. The implementing Rules and Regulations of this Act shall be formulated within Sixty (60)

days after the enactment of this law.

Section 9. Separability Clause. In the event any provision of this Act or the application of such provision is declared invalid, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected by such declaration.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. All laws and regulations under the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao including those laws passed under the Government of Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao regarding establishing and operations of Municipal Hospital not consistent with this Act are hereby repealed.

Section 11. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after its publication in 2 regional circulated newspaper.
