State shall foster the preservation, enrichment, and dynamic evolution of a Filipino

culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and

intellectual expression. It also mandates the State to conserve, develop, promote and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations. It further provides that all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the nation's cultural treasure and shall be under the protection of the State, which may regulate its disposition.

Consequently, Section 24, Article IX of the Bangsamoro Organic Law mandates the Bangsamoro Government to preserve the history, culture, art traditions, and the rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro people and their Sultanates, such as those of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the Royal House of Ranao and of the Iranum, and the non-Moro indigenous peoples of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region.

The Sultanate of Sulu was founded by Sultan Sharieful Hashim, who introduced Islamic political institutions and made Islam as the state religion. Thus, it is only befitting that we take steps to promote his invaluable contribution to our political consciousness and aspiration, by preserving, conserving and developing his tomb to serve as a constant reminder of our origin and illustrious past.

Furthermore, it will enhance and promote Tausug Culture and will contribute to the prestige of Sulu as the cradle of Bangsamoro government.

To be declared as a historical heritage site and an ecotourism destination, the Bangsamoro people will have the chance to experience heritage tourism that includes authentically representing the stories and people of the past, particularly the rich culture of the Province of Sulu and its people.

Hence, this proposal is an Act Declaring the Tomb of Sultan Sharieful Hashim as a historical heritage site and ecotourism destination.

I, therefore, humbly request my esteemed colleagues to help me pass this bill.

The "TOMB OF SULTAN SHARIEFUL HASHIM" located in Barangay 132 Buansa, Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu, is hereby declared as a historical heritage 133 site and an ecotourism destination. As such, its preservation and development shall be jointly prioritized by the Ministry of Trade, Investments and Tourism (MTIT) and the Bangsamoro 134 135 Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage (BCPCH). 136 Section 2. Within six (6) months after the approval of this Act, the MTIT, in 137

coordination with the BCPCH, the Provincial Tourism Office of the Province of Sulu and the

Municipal Tourism Office of the Municipality of Indanan and other concerned agencies of

government, shall prepare a historical heritage site conservation, development, and promotion plan, and an ecotourism development plan containing, among others, the rehabilitation, construction, installation, beautification, and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance tourism in the area and promote the Tausug Culture; Provided, that said development plan shall ensure the preservation of the natural beauty, cultural and historical significance of the site.

**Section 3**. The MTIT and the BCPCH, in coordination with the Ministry of Public Works (MPW), the Ministry of Environment, Natural Resources and Energy (MENRE), the Province of Sulu, and the Municipality of Indanan, shall take immediate steps to implement the historical heritage conservation, development, and promotion plan, and ecotourism development plan for the "Tomb of Sultan Sharieful Hashim," and shall incorporate the same in the Regional Tourism Development Plan that the MTIT shall hereafter develop.

**Section 4.** The BCPCH, MTIT, MPW, and MENRE shall include the implementation of this Act in their respective programs, the funding of which shall be included in the annual Bangsamoro Appropriations Act for the incoming fiscal year.

**Section 5.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the MTIT and the BCPCH shall jointly promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.

**Section 6.** All regional laws, rules, regulations inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed and amended accordingly.

**Section 7.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Bangsamoro Gazette or in a newspaper of regional circulation.
