AN ACT CREATING THE BANGSAMORO PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BPDA) IN THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR
SECTION 1. Name – This Act shall be known as the "Development Planning, Coordination, Monitoring and Evaluation Act of 2019".
SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy – The Bangsamoro Government shall adopt and implement continuing integrated and coordinated long, medium, and short term development plans and policies towards sustainable development of the Bangsamoro.
It is recognized that the formulation of socio-economic policies and plans is a vital process that calls for the participation of the government line agencies, private sector and other stakeholders at the regional level.
The formulation and adoption of these policies and plans need to be coordinated by a strong planning and development agency to ensure the consistency of policies, plans and programs for the sustainable use of the region's resources. To this end, the Parliament shall create an independent socio-economic and planning agency.
SECTION 3. Creation of the Bangsamoro Planning and Development
Authority— Pursuant to the above mentioned policies, the Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority (BPDA) is hereby created to serve as the socio-economic development planning and policy coordinating agency of the Bangsamoro Government. It shall serve as the Technical Secretariat of the Bangsamoro Economic and Development Council (BEDC) and the regional counterpart of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) in the BARMM.
The BPDA shall generate and provide impartial, objective and evidenced-based analyses and recommendations for the socio-economic advancement of the BARMM.
SECTION 4. Functions and Responsibilities of the BPDA — The BPDA shall have the following functions and responsibilities:
1. Coordinate and facilitate the formulation, implementation and monitoring and evaluation of the socio-economic development plans, policies, programs and

projects of the BARMM;

2. Review, evaluate and recommend short, medium and long-term development 1 plans, and proposed programs and projects for consideration by the BEDC; 2 3. Coordinate the annual and multi-year investment programming of the BARMM 3 ministries, line agencies and offices; 4 Provide technical assistance to the implementing ministries, line agencies and 5 offices, Local Government Units and other development partners in the BARMM 6 in identifying and developing plans, programs and projects; 7 5. Assist the Local Government Units in the BARMM on planning, investment 8 programming and other activities in support to local development; 9 6. Coordinate all regional, national and foreign assisted programs and projects in the 10 BARMM; 11 7. Conduct researches, statistical, and knowledge management and communication 12 related activities in support to planning, policy formulation, project development 13 and monitoring and evaluation; 14 8. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of programs and projects in the 15 BARMM; 16 9. Serve as the Technical Secretariat of the BEDC; 17 10. Perform such other appropriate tasks as may be assigned by the BEDC or other 18 competent authorities. 19 20 SECTION 6. Organizational Structure - The BPDA shall be headed by a 21 Director General to be assisted by Deputy Director General and three Bureau Directors. 22 23 The BPDA shall be composed of the following bureaus, services and divisions: 24 25 1. Planning and Policies Bureau (PPB) - The PPB shall coordinate and 26 facilitate the formulation of development policies and plans, investment 27 program, guidelines and priorities of the BARMM. It shall lead the 28 assessment, monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of plans, 29 programs and projects in the BARMM. It shall ensure a strong and efficient 30 linkage between development planning, programming and budgeting. 31 32 The PPB shall consist of the following divisions: 33 34 a. Macro-economic Planning Division 35 b. Economic Planning Division 36 c. Infrastructure Planning Division 37 d. Social Planning Division 38 39 e. Monitoring and Evaluation Division 40 2. Research Development and Special Projects Bureau (RDSPB)- The 41 RDSPB shall lead the preparation of relevant studies, researches and accurate 42 statistical data of the BARMM for timely and evidence-based planning, 43 project development and research agenda of the Bangsamoro Government. 44 45 The bureau will also coordinate activities related to the review and evaluation 46 of projects intended for Official Development Assistance (ODA) and national 47 government assistance for the socio-economic development of the BARMM. 48 49 The RDSPB shall consist of the following divisions: 50 51 a. Research and Development, and Information Technology Division 52 53 (RDITD) b. Official Development Assistance/Nationally Funded Programs and 54 Projects Coordination Assistance Division (ODA/NFPPCAD) and 55

- c. Local Planning and Development Assistance Division (LPDAD)
- 3. Finance and Administrative Support Services (FASS) The FASS shall provide financial and administrative support services to the BPDA.

The FASS shall consist of the following divisions:

- a. Finance Division (FD);
- b. Administrative Support Division (ASD)

SECTION 7. Office of the Director General — The operations and management functions of the BPDA shall be vested to the Director General who will also sit as Vice Chairperson of the Bangsamoro Economic Development Council (BEDC). The Director General shall also serve as the Chief Executive Officer immediately responsible for carrying out the mandate of the BPDA and the policies of the Council. The Director General shall be appointed by the Chief Minister with the following functions:

- 1. Provide executive direction and supervision over the entire operation of the BPDA;
- 2. Establish policies and standards for the effective and efficient operation of the BPDA in accordance with the programs of the government;
- 3. Promulgate policies as may be necessary in carrying out the BPDA mandates, plans, programs and projects;
- 4. Appoint, subject to civil service laws, rules and regulations, all subordinate officers and employees, who shall enjoy security of tenure and may be removed only for cause in accordance with law.
- 5. Exercise the power to discipline subordinate officials and employees under the provisions of law;
- 6. Coordinate the implementation of the policies and measures approved by the BEDC;
- 7. Prepare the annual budget for the operations of BPDA; and
- 8. Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Chief Minister.

SECTION 8. Staffing – The BPDA shall determine its staffing pattern, as well as responsibilities and functions of its divisions. It shall establish a human resource management system which shall govern the selection, hiring, appointment, transfer, promotion, or dismissal of all personnel. Such system shall aim to establish professionalism and excellence in the performance of its functions and responsibilities.

SECTION 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations. – Within 90 days from the approval of this Act, the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of this Act shall be promulgated and approved by the Chief Minister. The implementing rules and regulations provided for under this Act shall be reviewed periodically, and revised, if necessary.

SECTION 10. Appropriations – Funds necessary for BPDA operations shall be included in the annual appropriations of the BARMM submitted to the Parliament for approval, subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 11. Transfer of Functions and Assets of Regional Planning and Development Office (RPDO) to the Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority.

- All functions, programs, projects and activities which are being undertaken by the Regional Planning and Development Office (RPDO) including its Assets shall be transferred to the BPDA.

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. – Should any provision of this Act be found unconstitutional by a court of law, such provision shall be severed from the remainder of

12 13 14	SECTION 13. Repealing Clause. – All laws, decrees, letters of instruction, resolutions, orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.
15 16 17 18 19 20	SECTION 14. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of local circulation in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.
