6 **AN ACT ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL HYMN OF THE**
7 **BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM**

14 *Be it enacted by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority in session assembled:*

15 **SECTION 1.** *Adoption of the Official Bangsamoro Hymn.* – Pursuant to Article II,
16 Section 2 of Republic Act No. 11054, there is hereby adopted an Official Hymn of the
17 Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, hereinafter referred to as the
18 Bangsamoro Hymn.

19 **SECTION 2.** *Declaration of Policy.* – In the exercise of its right to self-
20 governance, the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao is free to adopt
21 its Bangsamoro Hymn that conveys and preserves the peoples' identity, history,
22 heritage, and aspirations.

23 **SECTION 3.** *Official Lyrics.* – The official lyrics of the Bangsamoro Hymn shall be
24 as follows:

25 *Simula noon hanggang ngayon*
26 *lisa ang naging layon*
27 *Magkaisa at magbuklod*
28 *Kagitingan ay marubdob*
29 *Tumayo tayo mula sa hamon ng nakaraan*
30 *Niyapos ang panganib na humahadlang*
31 *Pinangako sa puso at paniniwala*
32 *Ang ginhawang para sa kabataan*

35 *Bunga ng pawis, dugo, at buhay*
36 *Kapayapaan, katarungan*

13 **SECTION 4.** *Rendition of the Bangsamoro Hymn.* – The rendition of the
14 Bangsamoro Hymn, whether played or sung, shall always be in accordance with the
15 official musical arrangement and composition.

16 All public and private schools, colleges and universities, public offices,
17 government-owned or controlled corporations, and other government instrumentalities
18 within the Bangsamoro are required to play and sing the Bangsamoro Hymn during flag-
19 raising and flag lowering ceremonies. Other offices of the Bangsamoro that are outside
20 its area of autonomy are likewise required play and sing the Bangsamoro Hymn.

21 Where necessary, the Bangsamoro Hymn may also be played and sung in
22 ceremonial and symbolic functions and activities.

23 Whenever the Bangsamoro Hymn is sung, it shall always be preceded by the
24 singing of the Philippine National Anthem pursuant to Article II, Section 2 of Republic
25 Act No. 11054.

26 **SECTION 5.** *Appropriations.* – The amount of one million pesos (1,000,000.00
27 php) is hereby authorized to be charged to any funds of the Office of the Chief Minister
28 for the initial production and distribution of the Bangsamoro Hymn.

29 **SECTION 6.** *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
30 publication in a regional newspaper of general circulation in the Bangsamoro.
