**RESOLUTION**

**URGING THE BARMM GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE EXPANDED  
SCHOLARSHIP GRANT FOR DESERVING YOUTH WITHIN THE  
BARMM**

**WHEREAS**, according to Nelson Mandela, education is the most powerful weapon which we can use to change the world;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 2 paragraph 3, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution, the state shall establish and maintain a system of scholarship grants, and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially to the underprivileged;

**WHEREAS**, in Section 16 of Republic Act No 11054 known as Bangsamoro Organic Law, states that the Bangsamoro Government shall develop an educational framework relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people;

**WHEREAS**, scholarships provides an opportunity for many young people to earn an education. It instills a greater sense of belonging – and motivation – to make it through their higher education.

**WHEREAS**, without assistance from an outside source, students may have difficulty in acquiring the degree they need in order to enter the workforce and become a productive member of society.

**WHEREAS**, due to the enlarged land area of the BARMM, more underprivileged youth needs education;

**WHEREAS**, the existing number of youth beneficiaries of the scholarship program demands increase in relation to the increase of population in the BARMM;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cotabato and other areas of the BARMM composed of lot of talented and smart young people that needs further education;

**WHEREAS**, it is undeniable that a lot of young people are wasted due to lack of financial capacity for good education;

**WHEREAS**, youth education, through scholarships, in our government today shall greatly influence the adaptive capacity of our young people and our government in the future;

**WHEREAS**, scholarship grant made by our government will not only develop the knowledge of the youth but will also inculcate in them patriotism into our government;

**WHEREAS**, it is essential that the Bangsamoro government shall recognize the need to help the young people, especially the underprivileged, to support their education through scholarship grant.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that in recognizing the importance of scholarship grant, the following actions may be made:

1. That the BARMM government shall provide for additional scholarship program to provide a better chance and opportunity to poor but deserving students to study and see their way through state-owned colleges and universities or even in private schools in the locality and neighboring towns offering technical, vocational or college degree courses.
2. That the government shall act to help the young people not just to increase their knowledge but also to develop their skills and talents by supporting in the demand for effective trainers / coaches.
