A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE STANDARDIZATION OF THE FORMATS OF BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY DOCUMENTS TO BE INCORPORATED IN THE EXISTING PARLIAMENTARY RULES

WHEREAS, Article XVI, Sec. 3 of Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao provides in part Legislative and Executive powers in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region during transition shall be vested in the Bangsamoro Transition Authority. WHEREAS, the Bangsamoro Transition Authority had numerous accounts of filed bills, resolutions, committee reports and transcripts in the exercise of its Legislative powers.

WHEREAS, as a legal entity bounded by rules, the Bangsamoro Parliament shall have a standard format to reflect an official form applicable to all its documents and papers.

WHEREAS, there is a need to standardize the forms of bills, resolutions, committee reports and transcripts and all other legislative documents to have easy reference for all those who wish to utilize such.

WHEREAS, in the promotion of efficient use of paper, consistency and uniformity standardization of BTA forms is hereby set forth.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Parliament shall endeavor to create rules and regulations for the standardization of the forms and documents of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Parliament shall promote consistency and uniformity of forms and documents towards the advancement of a more efficient and effective legislation and in the delivery of its mandate conferred by law.
