**“RESOLUTION URGING THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH TO INCLUDE IN THEIR PRIMARY PROGRAM THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MOBILE/BUS HOSPITAL IN EVERY PROVINCES OF THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (BARMM) INCLUDING THE SIXTY-THREE (63) BARANGAYS IN NORTH COTABATO.”**

**WHEREAS**, under the national health policy of our country, the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services.

**WHEREAS**, RA 11054 enunciates that the Bangsamoro Government shall provide, maintain, and ensure the delivery of basic and responsive health programs.

**WHEREAS**, the Bangsamoro Government shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them. It shall also uphold the right to have access to essential goods, health, and other social services that promote their well-being.

**WHEREAS**, the Bangsamoro Government function is to cater the basic needs of its constituents and one of the identified needs is to maintain the good health and to provide health services for the people living in every community of the region;

**WHEREAS**, a mobile/bus hospital is a medical center or a small hospital with full medical equipment that can be moved and settled in a new place and situation swiftly. So it can provide medical services to patients or wounded persons in critical conditions especially in remote areas.

**WHEREAS**, there were numerous incidents that health care and service needed by the constituents requires accommodation to hospitals that are equipped with sufficient facilities and the provision of mobile/bus hospital to cater first aid and other major health problems is of vital importance.
