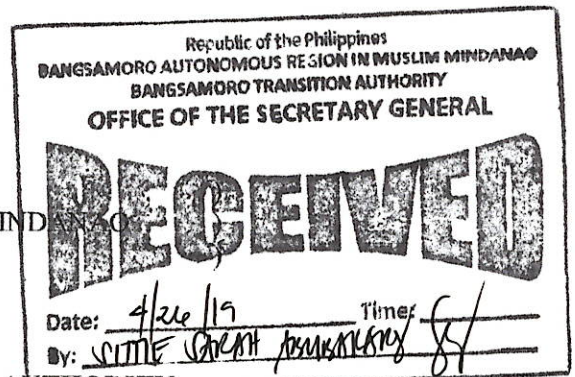

RESOLUTION

ACKNOWLEDGING THE CREATION OF PRIMARY MINISTRIES UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11054 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ORGANIC LAW FOR THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO" AND RECOGNIZES THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MINISTERS THERETO, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CHIEF MINISTER AND THE APPOINTED MINISTERS TO UTILIZE EXISTING ARMM STRUCTURE AND PERSONNEL, AND PERFORM NECESSARY FUNCTIONS AND MANDATES THEREFORE

WHEREAS, Sec. 7 Art. XVI of the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao mandates the interim Chief Minister to organize the interim Cabinet, appoint two (2) interim Deputy Chief Ministers, who shall also be members of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, and appoint such other ministers as may be necessary to perform the functions of government during the transition period, a majority of whom shall be from among the members of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority;

WHEREAS, Sec. 8 Art. XVI of the same organic law mentions the composition of the fifteen (15) primary ministries with sub offices;

WHEREAS, in Sec. 9 Art XVI of the same organic law, the Bangsamoro Transition Authority is vested with authority to create offices and organize the bureaucracy during the transition period. Nonetheless, in the exercise of such authority, the Bangsamoro Transition Authority shall ensure the least possible disruption to the functioning of government and the delivery of services in the region;

WHEREAS, the formal organizational structure of the Ministries mentioned in the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao are yet to be authorized by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority through the Bangsamoro Administrative Code, which is one of the priority legislation mandated by law and in the interim while the Transition Plan for the phase out of the ARMM agencies;

WHEREAS, the Bangsamoro Transition Authority is further mandated to schedule the gradual phasing out of offices of the Autonomous Regional Government in Muslim Mindanao, which are deemed abolished upon the ratification of this Organic Law, but in consideration of public interest and the delivery of services, officials holding appointive positions shall continue to perform their functions in accordance with the phase-out schedule.

RESOLVED, that the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, on behalf of its members:

1. Acknowledges the creation of the primary ministries mentioned in the Organic Law, and further recognizes the appointment of Ministers by the interim Chief Minister thereto;
2. Authorizes the interim Chief Minister and appointed Ministers to utilize the existing ARMM agencies and offices and personnel until the same are phased out in order not to disrupt delivery of services in the region.
3. Suggests further that agencies and offices whose functions and mandate pertain to or related to such ministries must be grouped and placed under the authority of the concerned Minister; For this purpose, the office of the interim Chief Minister must submit to the Bangsamoro Transition Authority the office or list of agencies and offices that fall under the same ministry based on its assessment subject to the approval of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority; and
4. Authorizes the appointed Ministers to initially draft and propose the structural organization and staffing pattern of each ministry under their authority, and to be assessed and recommended by the interim Chief Minister subject to review, deliberation and approval of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority and participate in the drafting and deliberation of the Administrative Code. Provided, that the creation of the different offices and their respective staffing complement shall be consistent with existing budgeting, organization, staffing, position classification and compensation policies, guidelines, and standards of the National Government pursuant Sec. 10 Art. XVI of the same Organic Law.

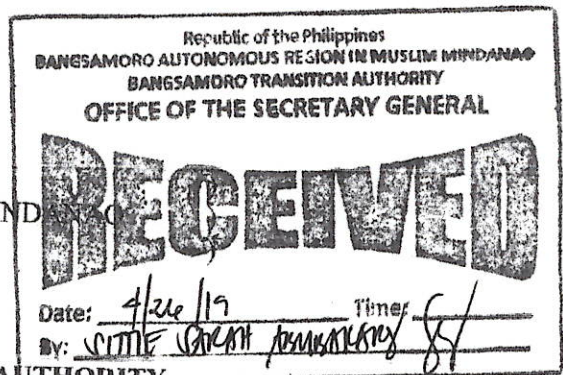
