PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 148

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REALIGNMENT OF THE UNEXPENDED PORTION OF THE PERSONAL SERVICES FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT PESOS (P8,485,158.00) REPRESENTING THE SAVINGS FROM THE SALARIES OF THE FIRST BATCH OF EMPLOYEES OF THE REGIONAL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY WHO WERE SEPARATED FROM THE SERVICE EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 31, 2019 PURSUANT TO THE PHASING OUT SCHEDULE OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEFUNCT AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (ARMM), FOR PAYMENT OF 14TH MONTH PAY BONUS OF STAFFERS OF EACH MEMBER OF THE PARLIAMENT ENTITLED BY LAW TO RECEIVE THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the funds of the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) under 2019 General Appropriations Act (GAA) was transferred to the Bangsamoro Transition Authority (BTA) pursuant to Section 14, Article 16 of Republic Act 11054, otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM);

WHEREAS, several employees of the Regional Legislative Assembly (RLA) were separated from the service effective October 31, 2019 as part of the first batch of the gradual phasing out of ARMM employees during the transition period, resulting to savings in the amount of Eight Million Four Hundred Eighty Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty Eight Pesos (P8,485,158.00);

WHEREAS, considering that there is no appropriation in the existing RLA budget for the payment of the 14th month pay bonus of the staffers of the Members of the Parliament who are entitled to the said benefit, there is a need to realign the said unexpended amount for the purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the realignment of the unexpended portion of the Personal Services fund in the amount of Eight Million Four Hundred Eighty Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty Eight Pesos (P8,485,158.00) representing the savings from the salaries of the first batch of employees of the Regional Legislative Assembly who were separated from the service effective october 31, 2019 pursuant to the phasing out schedule of the offices of the defunct Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM), for payment of 14th month pay bonus of staffers of the each Member of the Parliament entitled by law to receive the same.
