A RESOLUTION

FOR THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY TO EFFECTUATE AND SUBSEQUENTLY RECOGNIZE THE OFFICIAL TURN-OVER OF SIXTY THREE (63) BARANGAYS TO THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, Section 2, Article III of Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao provides that the composition of the territorial jurisdiction of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region is subject to plebiscite as provided in Section 3, Article XV of this Organic Law;

WHEREAS, the new Moro entity stands to realize the novel cause and collective aspirations of the people in the Bangsamoro land in pursuit of social justice and sustainable peace that will eventually spur inclusive economic growth in this part of the land consistent with the basic mandates of the Constitution and national sovereignty;

WHEREAS, the law endeavors to realize the full potential of the people within the Moro populated territories as vital cog of what exactly frames an essential harmonious and progressive society within the perspective of the Bangsamoro people;

WHEREAS, sixty three (63) of the sixty seven (67) barangays from six towns of the Cotabato Province overwhelmingly voted for their inclusion the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) during the second round of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) plebiscite held last February 6, 2019;

WHEREAS, in said plebiscite, seven (7) barangays in Carmen, seven (7) barangays in Kabacan, thirteen (13) barangays in Midsayap, twelve (12) barangays in Pigcawayan, two (2) barangays in Aleosan and twenty two (22) barangays in Pikit opted to join the new Moro government entity pursuant to Republic Act No. 11054, popularly known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law;

WHEREAS, recognizing that by virtue of the plebiscite, the concerned barangays have been included in the territorial jurisdiction of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, in light of the above, it is imperative for the Bangsamoro Government to recognize accordingly such official event together with the resultant legal implications in accordance with the mandate of R.A. No. 11054;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority:

FOR THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION GOVERNMENT TO RECOGNIZE THE OFFICIAL TURN OVER OF THE SIXTY THREE (63) BARANGAYS TO BARMM GOVERNMENT with the end in view of strengthening the local government units pursuant to the principle of local autonomy and R.A. No. 11054, otherwise known as the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.
