A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE CHIEF MINISTER FOR THE UNION OF MORO LEADERS OF THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO AS INTEGRAL PART OF ITS PROGRAM VIS-À-VIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS PROVIDED UNDER THE BANGSAMORO ORGANIC LAW

Whereas, RA 11054, known as Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL), provides under Article VI, Section 9. Council of Leaders. - There shall be a Council of Leaders that shall advise the Chief Minister on matters of governance in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. It shall consist of the following members: (a) Chief Minister as head of the council; (b) Members of the Congress of the Philippines from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region; (c) Provincial governors, and mayors of chartered cities in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;(d) Representatives of traditional leaders, outside of the Bangsamoro communities outside of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region; and (e) Representatives of other sectors;

Whereas, under the last paragraph of aforementioned provision of the law states that the mechanism of representation and number of representatives in paragraphs (d) and (e) shall be determined by the Parliament. The representation of the non-Moro indigenous communities shall be pursuant to their customary laws and indigenous processes.

Whereas, with the issuance of the Memorandum dated October 14, 2019 which designates National Government representatives to the Intergovernmental Relations between the National Government and the Bangsamoro Government of the BARMM;

Whereas, given the significance of the events, it is an high time for the Bangsamoro Leaders to solidify themselves under the shade of One Voice for the Bangsamoro People which will embody the common good of all and continue upholding the principle of all-inclusiveness among the Moro Leaders and Bangsamoro People as a whole;

Whereas, it has been public clamor reverberating in very nook and corner of BARMM Region for the Unification of Bangsamoro Leaders among the various

sectors, business, youth, women, traditional, Moro National Liberation Front, Moro Islamic Liberation Front leaders;


Whereas, this popular clamor is anchored on advancing their common platforms and programs beneficial to all, national and regional governments, to public officials as well as the common Bangsamoro People;

Wherefore, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that this August Assembly will call for the Chief Minister to invite more Moro Leaders and convene them to discuss matters designed to strengthen the unity of Moro People;

Be it resolved further that activities or an assembly be held the soonest time possible to explore ways and means to establish greater linkages and foster collaborative efforts among the Moro Leaders of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Government vis a vis the national government programs and policies;

Be it resolved finally that members of the August Body be part of the said assembly to hear the sentiments and aspiration of the Bangsamoro Leaders as part of its program in aid of legislation.
