PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 176

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING TO SET THE SCHEDULE OF THE IMMEDIATE RETURN
(KAMBALINGAN) OF MARAWI INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs)
ORIGINALLY RESIDING IN MOST AFFECTED AREA (MAA) IN MARAWI CITY**

WHEREAS, the Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement states that IDPs are entitled to enjoy without discrimination the same rights and freedom under international and domestic law as do other persons in their country. It provides for durable solutions, one of which is the sustainable reintegration at the place of origin of the IDPs or referred herein as **return**;


WHEREAS, the Tasked Force Bangon Marawi (TFBM), leading government agency tasked to rehabilitate Marawi City, has been promising several times to allow the evacuees to return home but these have been breached;

WHEREAS, during the Public Consultation on the status of Marawi Rehabilitation, it appears that the main sentiment and appeal of the Civil Society Organization representing the Marawi IDPs is for the TFBM to permit them to go home; they stated that the government deprives them of their rights guaranteed in the constitution and the TFBM has failed in its mandate to rehabilitate Marawi;

WHEREAS, resolving internal displacement by allowing the IDPs to return home is inextricably linked to achieving lasting peace;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Parliament to set the speedy schedule of the KAMBALINGAN of IDPs residing in MAA in Marawi City
