RESOLUTION PROVIDING SCHOLARSIP GRANT TO UNDERPRIVILEGED BANGSAMORO GRADUATES OF ALL PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS (UBGPHS) THAT GO TO COLLEGES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the State to establish and maintain a **system of scholarship grants**, student loan programs, subsidies, and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially to the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, number 4 of the 12-Point Priority Agenda states that the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao shall setup and implement programs and projects that will respond to the pressing social and economic challenges in the Bangsamoro such as **poverty**, **education**, health...;

WHEREAS, based on Functional Literacy, Education and Mass Media Survey, the Bangsamoro is the highest across regions that have out-of-school youth or not able to go to college, aged 15 to 24 years, and the top reasons therefor are: insufficient family income and highest cost of education;

WHEREAS, UBGPHS are vulnerable to recruitment by violent extremism groups. When youth are supposed to be in school but are forced to earn for the family or when they are not able to go to college, violent extremism groups use the opportunity for recruitment by providing cash incentives;

WHEREAS, in order for UBGPHS continue schooling and not fall into the influence of radicalization, this Parliament is beseeched to help them fulfill their dream;
