RESOLUTION URGING THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATION TO COME UP WITH AN APPLICABLE MECHANISMS THAT WILL REGULATE THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATIONS TO PUT SIGNAGES IN THE ROADS AND STREETS COMMENDING THE ALMIGHTY FOR A SAFE TRIPS WITHIN THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO.

Whereas, the Interim Chief Minister envisaged the Moral Governance, it is but necessary to set standards which are within the bounds of what is moral in the public transportations within the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao;

Whereas, Article 18, Universal Declaration of Human Rights¹, Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion; this right includes freedom to change his religion or belief, and freedom, either alone or in community with others and in public or private, to manifest his religion or belief in teaching, practice, worship and observance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Bangsamoro Transition Authority Parliament through the Ministry of Transportation and Communication to come up with mechanisms that will regulate the public transportations to put signages commending the Almighty.
