**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE 1ST BARMM MISMO: YOUTH VOLUNTEERS
SUMMIT HELD ON MARCH 21-22, 2020 AT COTABATO CTY**

WHEREAS, section 13 of Article IX of the Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law provides:

The Bangsamoro Government shall recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building, promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate patriotism and nationalism, encourage involvement in public and civic affairs, and promote mental and physical fitness through sports;

WHEREAS, founded on 27 May 2018, National Youth Volunteers Coalition (NYVC) is an organization composed of youth volunteers, advocates, and youth organizations that come together in an expression of solidarity, fuelled by passion, purpose and commitment to rekindle the spirit of “bayanihan” and patriotism among the youth and citizenry. NYVC vows to strengthen the level of awareness, knowledge, and understanding on volunteerism towards nation building, thus the birth of MISMO: Youth Volunteers Summit. MISMO: Youth Volunteers Summit is a project caravan of NYVC travelling across the country to gather the youth volunteers and celebrate their initiatives towards nation-building;

WHEREAS, NYVC being a strong influencer among aspiring youth leaders, has launched its Project #BoluntirMISMO. The following aims of MISMO are in consistent with the basic rights of the youth provided in both Philippine Constitution and the Bangsamoro Organic Law, to wit:

- 1. To build nationwide public awareness and appreciation on the power of volunteerism and the role it plays in the social, economic and political development of the country;*
- 2. To create environment for bolstering voluntary action in development; and*
- 3. To recognize the noble acts of volunteerism by individuals, families, institutions, and communities as vital partners in economic and community development.*

WHEREAS, with the foregoing mission, the NYVC will conduct a two-day Camp Activity called: BARMM MISMO with the theme: “Mainstreaming Bangsamoro Volunteerism and Heroism” on March 21-22 this year in Cotabato City;

WHEREAS, for the first time the Bangsamoro Government will participate in the aforementioned Summit;

WHEREAS, in order to promote the social-building of the Bangsamoro Youth, as mandated by no less than the Philippine Constitution and the Bangsamoro Organic Law, there is indeed a need to support our Bangsamoro Youth;


NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to call out the Bangsamoro Transition Authority to support the Bangsamoro youth volunteers in the first BARMM MISMO Summit with the end in view of strengthening/empowering youth in the Bangsamoro region.


