RESOLUTION

**CALLING FOR THE CREATION OF AN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON
MARAWI CITY SIEGE REHABILITATION**

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article 6, Republic Act No. 11054, also known as Bangsamoro Organic Law, provides for the power of the Bangsamoro to supplement the efforts of the National Government in the rehabilitation of Marawi City devastated on May 23, 2017 by ISIS-inspired groups. The pertinent provision provides:

SEC. 13. National Programs and Projects. - National programs and projects such as the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program, Health Facility Enhancement Program, School Building Program, retained hospitals of the Department of Health, PhilHealth, social pension for senior citizens, and **a Marawi rehabilitation program shall continue to be funded by the National Government, without prejudice to the power of the Bangsamoro Government to provide for supplemental funding for such programs and projects.**

WHEREAS, to enable the Bangsamoro Government to exercise effectively its powers under the BOL, there is a need to create an Oversight Committee on Marawi City Rehabilitation that shall coordinate, monitor and complement the National Government efforts in the ongoing rehabilitation of Marawi City.

WHEREAS, the said committee shall be responsible in reporting to the BTA and the Bangsamoro Government represented by the Interim Chief Minister any developments and recommendations for the successful and effective implementation of programs and projects led by the National Government without prejudice to the supplemental support of the Bangsamoro Government in fulfillment of its mandate to report and rehabilitate conflict affected areas in the Bangsamoro.



Now, therefore, be it-
