RESOLUTION
RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE HEROISM, BRAVERY AND
DEDICATION OF ALL THE BANGSAMORO FRONTLINERS IN
BATTLING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Section 22, Article IX of Republic Act 11054 or the *Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao* states that the Bangsamoro Government shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them. It shall also uphold the peoples' right to have access to essential goods health, and other social services that promote their well-being.

WHEREAS, The Bangsamoro Government as provided in the same Section shall assist and cooperate with the National Government in the provision of quarantine services for the prevention and control of epidemic and other communicable diseases.

WHEREAS, On March 9, 2020, **PRESIDENT RODRIGO DUTERTE** placed entire country under the state of public health emergency through Proclamation No. 922 due to increasing number of confirmed cases of Corona Virus Disease or COVID-19 in the country;

WHEREAS, On March 16, 2020, the entire areas in Bangsamoro Region in Muslim Mindanao were placed in Enhanced Community Quarantine to prevent the entry and spread of covid-19 pandemic in the region,

WHEREAS, On the same date or on March 16, 2020 the Regional Inter-Agency Task Force of the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (RIATF) was created in order to ensure inter-ministry collaboration in establishing preparedness, awareness, prevention and containment of Covid-19 in the region;

WHEREAS, the health and emergency frontline services were ensured through the active and zealous front liners from regional to barangay level;
