**A RESOLUTION**

**EXPRESSING SYMPATHY AND MOST SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY ON THE DEMISE OF FR. TERESITO "CHITO" SUGANOB VICAR-GENERAL OF THE PRELATURE OF MARAWI**

**WHEREAS**, Fr. Teresito "Chito" Suganob served as the Vicar-General of Prelature of Marawi for 26 years and distinguished himself as an advocate of peace, education and interfaith dialogue among the tri-people of Mindanao;

**WHEREAS**, from May 23 to September 16, 2017, the late Fr. Suganob was held hostage by the combined forces of the Abu Sayaff and Maute Group during the Marawi Siege;

**WHEREAS**, after his release from captivity, he continued to support the Mindanao Peace Process and actively participated in the campaign for the passage of the Bangsamoro Organic Law during the 17<sup>th</sup> Congress;

**WHEREAS**, on October 18, 2017, during the 16<sup>th</sup> Mindanao Sulu Pastoral Conference, Davao City's Archbishop Emeritus Fernando Capalla described the late Fr. Suganob as the "Martyr of Dialogue";

**WHEREAS**, the late Fr. Suganob will definitely be missed by his friends and family in the peacebuilding community of Mindanao;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority (BTA) to express, as it is hereby expresses, its sympathy and most sincere condolences to the family of Fr. Teresito "Chito" Suganob and to the Catholic Community, on his passing on July 22, 2020;
