WHEREAS, on December 22, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte appointed Atty. Amanodin-Umpa as an Associate Justice of the Court of Appeals;

WHEREAS, Atty. Anisah B. Amanodin-Umpa is the first Bangsamoro woman to be appointed as an Associate Justice of the Court of Appeals;
