**A RESOLUTION URGING THE BANGSAMORO GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE  
MINISTRY OF BASIC AND HIGHER EDUCATION TO INITIATE THE  
INTEGRATION OF SCHOOL CURRICULUM IN ALL COLLEGES AND  
UNIVERSITIES, BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE, WITHIN BANGSAMORO  
AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO**

**WHEREAS**, Section 8, Article IX of Republic Act No. 11054 provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall provide, maintain, and ensure the delivery of basic and responsive health programs, *quality education*, appropriate services, livelihood opportunities, affordable and progressive housing projects, power and electricity, and water inhabitants of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

**WHEREAS**, Article IX, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 11054 further provides for the Integrated System of Quality Education which states that it shall be a top priority of the Bangsamoro Government to establish, maintain, and support a complete and integrated system of quality education, which shall be a subsystem of the national education system. The Bangsamoro Government shall develop an educational framework relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people;

**WHEREAS**, non- uniformity of descriptive title in all courses will cause substantial delay in the continuous flow education and will entail expenses to parents and students;

**WHEREAS**, curriculum changes are intended to improve the quality of education for the benefit of learners and teachers. The problem of non- accredited subjects from one school to another is a challenged that can be resolved through unification of curriculum;

**WHEREAS**, an integrated curriculum will support the quality teaching and learning by providing first class curricula to educators and students. It presents a
