**A RESOLUTION CALLING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DAY OF BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR POST COVID-19 VACCINATION RECIPIENTS WHO EXPERIENCE SERIOUS ADVERSE EFFECTS**

**WHEREAS**, a sponsored Bill No. 2057 or the proposed COVID-19 Vaccination Program Act of 2021 endorsed by the Senate Finance Committee for plenary approval, a measure that would ensure availability of national funds to compensate Filipinos in case of death or medical treatment arising from serious adverse effects of the COVID-19 vaccine;

**WHEREAS**, the sponsored Bill No. 2057 also mandates to create a special task group composed of medical and vaccine experts who will monitor the probable effects following immunization;

**WHEREAS**, Section 3, Article V of R.A. No. 11054, otherwise known as Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao mandates that "Bangsamoro Government shall exercise the power expressly granted, xxx among others, those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare. Within its territorial jurisdiction, the Bangsamoro Government shall ensure and support, among other things, xxx, promote health and safety, xxx and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, the general welfare, promotion of health and safety and preservation of the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants mentioned in the preceding paragraph embraces the disposal of financial assistance incidental and pursuant to Legislative Act;

**WHEREAS**, in consonance with the sponsored Bill No. 2057 or the proposed COVID-19 Vaccination Program Act of 2021, the Bangsamoro Government in cognizance of the need to allocate financial resources aim to ensure funds availability to compensate and provide humanitarian assistance to Bangsamoro People in the event of serious adverse effects of COVID-19 vaccine;

**WHEREAS**, this resolution also emulate the need to create a special task group composed of medical and vaccine experts who will monitor the probable effects following immunization in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao territories.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority:
