**BTA RESOLUTION No. 40 S OF 2019**

**Introduced by BTA Member ABDULMUHMIN A. MUJAHID**

“RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE DIFFERENT MINISTRIES OF THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (BARMM), TO OBSERVE PRIOR RIGHTS RESERVED FOR THE LOCAL APPLICANTS IN HIRING EMPLOYEES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICES PARTICULARLY THOSE PERSONNEL TO BE ASSIGNED IN THE DIFFERENT LOCALITIES OF THE AUTONOMOUS REGION TO AVOID DISENCHANTMENT AMONG THE PEOPLE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY”.

**WHEREAS**, Section 7, Article IV, Republic Act No. 11054, provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall ensure every Filipino citizen in its territorial jurisdiction the provision of the basic necessities and equal opportunities in life. Social justice shall be promoted in all aspects of life and phases of development in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

**WHEREAS**, Section 4, Rule V, Republic Act No. 8371, otherwise known as IPRA law of 1997, likewise provides that the right of member of Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples Communities to employment includes the rights to; be free from any form of discrimination, with respect to recruitment of employment, enjoy equal opportunities for admission to employment, both skilled and unskilled, and the right to be informed of their rights and privileges under existing labor laws and to equal protection of their rights;

WHEREAS, there is a need of prioritizing local applicants for hiring of local employment in the different Ministries under BARMM to accommodate qualified former combatants of both the MNLF and MILF and their immediate heirs to avoid resentment from them to ensure their full support to the Bangsamoro Transition Authority and the coming Bangsamoro Regular Government in 2022.

Now therefore, be it,

RESOLVED BY THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY, calling for the different Ministries under the Bangsamoro Transition Authority of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region to observe protocol of prior rights reserved to the local applicants in hiring employees in their respective offices to avoid disenchantment of the people in the community.
