RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE BANGSAMORO HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION AND THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS NATIONAL TO LOOK INTO THE RECENT SERIES OF ILLEGAL/WARRANTLESS ARRESTS OF THE BANGSAMORO CONSTITUENTS RESIDING AND WORKING IN METRO MANILA FOR THEIR SURVIVAL;

Whereas, it is being recalled that the **Bangsamoro Transition Authority (BTA) Parliament adopted resolution No. 239, last July 2, 2020**, which is entitled; "Resolution respectfully appealing to his excellency President Rodrigo Roa Duterte to veto Senate Bill No. 1083 and House Bill No. 6875 or the Anti-Terrorism Act of 2020, to provide congress the opportunity to review and address the issue of vagueness over-breath, and other concerns" (**Now officially designated as R.A. 11479**), otherwise known as the **Anti-Terrorism Act of 2020**;

Whereas, while we agree that among those essential elements to stabilize government bureaucracies by way of limiting substantial freedoms, including expression of dissents. **Nonetheless**, we likewise believe that under the terrorism law, an incident of violations of Human Rights will cause instability and could foster division lest embolden extremist's campaign to recruit further into their fold;

Whereas, just recently, as a consequence of said Terror Act, at least eleven (11) Bangsamoro constituents innocent construction workers illegally raided and arrested by police personnel in Metro Manila, Thus; definitely a blatant violation of their human rights and **Section 1, Art. III of the 1987 constitution**, provides that " No person shall be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law, nor shall any person be denied the equal protection of the laws;

Whereas, further states under **Section 2, of the same Bill of Rights** " The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures of whatever nature and for any purpose shall be inviolable, and no search warrant or warrant of arrest shall be issued **EXCEPT** upon probable cause to be determined personally by the judge after examination under oath or affirmation of the complainant and the witnesses he may produce, particularly describing the place to be searched and the persons or things to be seized;

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority (BTA), that a resolution is earnestly requesting the Bangsamoro Human Rights Commission and the Commission on Human Rights National to look into the recent series of illegal/warrantless arrests of the Bangsamoro constituents residing and working in metro manila for survival.
