

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE DEEPEST CONDOLENCES AND PROFOUND SYMPATHY OF THE BANGSAMORO PARLIAMENT OF THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF FORMER LANAO DEL SUR PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR PRINCESS TARHATA ALANGADI ALONTO LUCMAN ON HER UNTIMELY DEMISE.

WHEREAS, in Marawi City on February 26, 2021 at the age of 95 years old, Princess Tarhata Alangadi Alonto Lucman peacefully returned to her creator after suffering from a sudden cardiac arrest;

WHEREAS, Princess Tarhata Alangadi Alonto Lucman was the fourth child of Bai Bariga Alangadi, a direct descendant of Sultan Muhammad Dipatuan Kudarat, and the Sultan of Ramin, Senator Alauya Alonto, who served as a delegate of Lanao in the Philippine Constitutional Convention of 1934 which eventually caused his election as the first Maranao Senator under the Philippine Commonwealth in 1935;

WHEREAS, Princess Tarhata is the sister of Senator Domocao Alangadi Alonto, Hajja Naima Alangadi Alonto, Ambassador Abdul Ghaffur Alangadi Alonto, Datu Masiding Alangadi Alonto, Datu Madrigal Alangadi Alonto and Hajja Zubaidah Alonto, and she is the wife of the Sultan of Bayang, Congressman Haroun Al-Rashid Lucman, a World War II guerrilla hero known as one of the pioneering Moro statesmen that advocated for Moro independence;

WHEREAS, Princess Tarhata was elected as the first lady provincial governor of Lanao del Sur in 1971 where during her stint she prioritized the strengthening of ties between the Muslims and Christians in her area and spearheaded the peaceful settlements of *ridos* (clan feuds) while promoting esteemed collaborations among stakeholders in pushing for reforms in government;

WHEREAS, when Martial Law was declared in 1972, she defied tyranny and stood her ground against oppression that led to her unceremonious removal from office and subsequent exile to Saudi Arabia in 1975;

WHEREAS, after the EDSA People Power Revolution in 1986, she returned to the Philippines to continue her advocacies for peace part of which was the safe release of Fr. Michael de Gigord, Brian Lawrence as well as ten Filipino nuns abducted in Marawi City during said year;

WHEREAS, Princess Tarhata Alangadi Alonto Lucman is an embodiment of Bangsamoro women empowerment breaking cultural barriers in promoting women participation in governance making her an icon of good governance and inspiring generations of Bangsamoro leaders;

WHEREAS, this expression of condolence and sympathy may not be enough to demonstrate her achievements in good governance and public service but this is, however, a genuine and indisputable tribute to a public figure whose memory and legacy cannot be expressed by mere words alone, hence, this Bangsamoro Parliament shares the grief and loss of the bereaved family;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, to express the deepest condolences and profound sympathy of the Bangsamoro Parliament of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao to the bereaved family of former Lanao del Sur Provincial Governor Princess Tarhata Alangadi Alonto Lucman on her untimely demise.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to forward this Resolution to the bereaved family members of Princess Tarhata, for their information.
