RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE BANGSAMORO COMMISSION FOR THE PRESERVATION OF CULTURAL HERITAGE (BCPCH) TO IDENTIFY, COLLECT, DOCUMENT AND PROMOTE THE LIFE STORIES OF PUBLIC FIGURES WHO MADE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE HISTORY OF THE BANGSAMORO.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10908, otherwise known as the Integrated History Act of 2016 mandates the integration of Filipino-Muslim and Indigenous peoples history, culture and identity in the study of Philippine History in both basic and higher education;

WHEREAS, corollary thereof, Section 24 of Republic Act No. 11054 commonly known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) provides the responsibility of the Bangsamoro Government to preserve the history, culture, art, traditions and rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro people;

WHEREAS, Section 47, Chapter 4 of Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13, known as the Bangsamoro Administrative Code (BAA) enables the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage (BCPCH) to write the history of the Bangsamoro people and to establish the cultural institutions, programs and projects in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, the history of the Bangsamoro is characterized by various public figures who made significant contributions in our history as a people and it is imperative that their biographies will be identified, collected, documented and promoted for valuable recognition and posterity;

WHEREAS, this Bangsamoro Parliament found the urgent need to search, gather and record the memoirs of several Bangsamoro personalities that moulded our glorious history and systematically document their achievements for the benefit of future generations.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the BCPCH to identify, collect, document and promote the life stories of public figures who made significant contributions in the history of the Bangsamoro.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to forward this Resolution to the concerned agency, for its compliance and information.
