WHEREAS, on August 15, 2021, MP Bato peacefully returned to his creator at his hometown in Lanao del Sur;

WHEREAS, his comrades in the Bangsamoro cause, as well as his colleagues in the Bangsamoro Parliament, will surely miss his presence and wisdom as they continue with the Bangsamoro's quest for self-determination, peace, and justice.
