**RESOLUTION URGING MEMBERS OF THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION
AUTHORITY TO POST BOND**

WHEREAS, Section 41, Article VII of the Bangsamoro Organic Law provides "Public office is a public trust. Public officers and employees shall at all times be accountable to the people, serve them with utmost responsibility, integrity, loyalty, and efficiency, act with patriotism and justice, and lead modest lives".

WHEREAS, an accountable official is an employee of the government of the Philippines whose duties performed permit or require the custody of funds or properties for which he is accountable;

WHEREAS, Fidelity Bond is an assurance of bondable public officer under the Fidelity Fund to assure his faithful performance of the duties imposed by law and faithful accountability of all funds and public property coming into his possession, custody and control;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of the Treasury shall bond all accountable public officials and employees pursuant to the provisions of the Public Bonding Law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to require all members of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, as accountable officials, to post bond according to the provisions of the Public Bonding Law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the payment for the posting of bond be charged to the allotment downloaded by the Department of Budget and Management subject to usual accounting and audit rules and regulations;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Office of the Secretary-General facilitate the compliance, processing and submission of the documentary requirements.
