A RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE MINISTRY OF BASIC, HIGHER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (MBHTE) TO APPRISE THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY (BTA)
PARLIAMENT OF THE CURRENT STATE OF EDUCATION IN THE BANGSAMORO
REGION

WHEREAS, Section 7, Article IX of R.A. 11054 or the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall provide, maintain, and ensure the delivery of basic and responsive health programs, quality education, appropriate services, livelihood opportunities, affordable and progressive housing projects, power and electricity, and water inhabitants of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, Section 8, Chapter 2 of Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 18 or the Bangsamoro Education Code provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall promote and protect the constitutional right of all to quality education and accessible education at all levels and to establish, maintain, and support a complete, adequate, and integrated system of education relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people;

WHEREAS, the MBHTE is one of the primary ministries established under Section 8, Article XVI of the BOL;

WHEREAS, the MBHTE, as provided in Section 16, Article IX of BOL, shall be responsible for the establishment, maintenance, and support of a complete and integrated system of quality education;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has drastically affected education systems around the globe, including the Bangsamoro Region, to adopt alternative learning modalities to protect the learners from the spread of the virus through distance learning via online classes, the use of self-learning modules, or television and radio educational programs, among others;

WHEREAS, the prolonged pandemic school closures have adversely affected the students;

WHEREAS, it is imperative upon the Bangsamoro Government to seek continuous efforts in nurturing the students by providing quality education for the betterment of the Bangsamoro Youth;

WHEREAS, the MBHTE is requested to apprise the BTA on the status of education in the Bangsamoro Region to determine the impact of the pandemic to the region's basic education sector and more importantly, for the BTA to address the challenges facing the Bangsamoro Region with regard to education and to ensure immediate and efficient response from the Bangsamoro Government;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BTA Parliament, to pass and approve this Resolution: A Resolution Requesting the MBHTE to Apprise the BTA Parliament of the Current State of Education in the Region.
