RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY THAT IT FULLY SUPPORTS THE CALL OF THE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs) OF MARAWI CITY TO RETURN TO THEIR RESPECTIVE PROPERTIES AT THE MOST AFFECTED AREA (MAA)

WHEREAS, under the United Nations Guiding Principles of Internal Displacement, "displacement shall not be carried in a manner that violates the right to life, dignity, liberty, and security of those affected;"

WHEREAS, the Marawi Siege occurred on May 23, 2017 which caused the displacement of thousands of its constituents;

WHEREAS, since May 23, 2017 when the siege began, the displacement lasted for four (4) years and (4) four months;

WHEREAS, according to the report of the Task Force Bangon Marawi (TFBM), eighty (80%) of the rehabilitation project has been accomplished which include the construction of the barangay complex, cultural centers, 5 mosques (masjeeds) and roads;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Article IX of R.A. 11054 (BOL) provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall fully respect human rights;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority:

THAT THE BANGSAMORO TRANSITION AUTHORITY EXPRESSES ITS SENSE THAT IT FULLY SUPPORTS THE CALL OF THE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs) OF MARAWI CITY TO RETURN TO THEIR RESPECTIVE PROPERTIES AT THE MOST AFFECTED AREA (MAA)
