**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE POLICY OF THE OFFICE OF THE
CHIEF MINISTER (OCM) FOR THE REPRESENTATION OF THE
BANGSAMORO IN THE AFFAIRS OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT
THROUGH ITS AGENCIES AND OFFICES AS ORDAINED BY THE
BANGSAMORO ORGANIC LAW**

WHEREAS, Section 2, Article IV of R.A. No. 11054 of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) provides that in the exercise of its right to self-governance, the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region is free to pursue its political, economic, social and cultural development as provided for in the Organic Law;

WHEREAS, Section 11, Article VI of the BOL provides that as far as practicable, the Bangsamoro Government shall be represented in the departments, offices, commissions, agencies and bureaus of the National Government that implement and enforce policies, programs, and projects of the National Government in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, Section 32, Article VII of the BOL provides that the Chief Minister shall represent the Bangsamoro Government in the affairs of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, Section 3, Article V of the BOL provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall exercise the power expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare. Within its territorial jurisdiction, the Bangsamoro Government shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture,

promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among its residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, in adherence to the mandate of the Bangsamoro Government as provided by the BOL, to promote the general welfare of its people, it is imperative to support the policy of the OCM to represent the Bangsamoro in the affairs of the National Government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BTA Parliament to pass and approve this Resolution Supporting the Policy of the Office of the Chief Minister (OCM) for the Representation of the Bangsamoro in the Affairs of the National Government Through its Agencies and Offices as Ordained by the BOL.
