A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DAY THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE MINISTRIES AND AGENCIES TO APPRISE THE BTA PARLIAMENT ON THE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONALLY-FUNDED PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS IN THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION

WHEREAS, consistent with national policy, national government agencies are implementing their regular national programs and projects in the former Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao until the time the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region has been established;

WHEREAS, to ensure successful implementation of the national programs and projects, the national government had adopted different implementation modalities to include: a) Implementation by Administration, b) Implementation by Contract, and c) Implementation by Memorandum of Agreement;

WHEREAS, upon the establishment of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region by virtue of the Organic Law and abolishing the former ARMM some of the nationally-funded programs and projects in BARMM by sectoral dimension were taken over by the Bangsamoro Government. This includes among others projects under the Department of Agriculture (DA), Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), Department of Health (DOH), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), and Department of Science and Technology (DOST);

WHEREAS, despite the establishment of BARMM, the national programs and projects such as *Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino* Program, Health Facility Enhancement Program, School Building Program, retained hospitals of the

Department of Health, PhilHealth, social pension for senior citizens, and the Task Force *Bangon* Marawi shall continue to be funded by the National Government, without prejudice to the power of the Bangsamoro Government to provide for supplemental funding for such programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the status and update of the implementation of nationally-funded programs and projects in BARMM will aid policy actions of the Parliament in the successful implementation of nationally-funded programs and projects in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the BTA Parliament to pass and approve this Resolution requesting the Government of the Day through the appropriate Ministries and Agencies to apprise the BTA Parliament on the status of the implementation of nationally-funded programs and projects in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region.
