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**RESOLUTION**

**URGING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DAY (GOTD) TO SUPPORT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CAMPS TRANSFORMATION PLAN (CTP) AND ITS ACCOMPANYING CAMPS TRANSFORMATION INVESTMENT PROGRAM (CTIP) TO ADVANCE THE POST-CONFLICT REHABILITATION AND TRANSFORMATION IN THE BANGSAMORO REGION**

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2014, the Government of the Philippines (GPH) and the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) signed the Comprehensive Agreement on the Bangsamoro (CAB), which marked the end of 17 years of negotiations between the Parties and provided a negotiated political settlement for the attainment of a just and lasting peace and development in the Bangsamoro Region;

**WHEREAS**, the Annex on Normalization, signed on January 24, 2014, is an integral part of the CAB. It provides for a process to ensure human security in the Bangsamoro and enable the communities to achieve their desired quality of life through the pursuit of sustainable livelihood and political participation within a peaceful and deliberative society;

**WHEREAS**, the annex of the normalization provides for confidence-building measures that may be undertaken through Joint Task Forces for the six (6) previously acknowledged MILF camps with the end in view of transforming these areas into peaceful and productive communities;

**WHEREAS**, the JTFCT was tasked to assess the needs, formulate a comprehensive and integrated development plan, and undertake the necessary measures in transforming the six (6) MILF camps specifically Camp Bilal in Lanao del Norte and Lanao del Sur, Camp Omar ibn al-Khattab in Maguindanao, Camp Rajamuda in North Cotabato and Maguindanao, Camp Busrah Somiorang in Lanao del Sur, Camp Badre in Maguindanao, and Camp Abubakar as-Siddique in Maguindanao, into peaceful and productive communities;

**WHEREAS**, in order to effectively deliver its mandate, the JTFCT, through the support of the Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process (OPAPP), initiated the formulation of the Camps Transformation Plan (CTP) and its accompanying Camps Transformation Investment Program (CTIP);

**WHEREAS**, the JTFCT engaged with the Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority (BPDA) for the conduct of the CTP and CTIP planning exercises. The BPDA with JTFCT Secretariat conducted a series of consultative meetings and planning workshops in the six camps for the formulation of CTP and CTIP;

**WHEREAS**, the CTP and the accompanying CTIP is aligned and consistent with the priorities of the Bangsamoro Government as articulated in the Bangsamoro Development Plan (BDP) 2020-2022;

**WHEREAS**, following the agreements stated in the CAB, the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) was signed into law on July 27, 2018 and was ratified through plebiscites held on January 21 and February 06, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, Section 1, Article XIV of the BOL provides that the Bangsamoro Government, with funding support from the National Government, shall intensify development efforts for the rehabilitation, reconstruction, and development of Bangsamoro Autonomous Region (BARMM) as part of the normalization process. It shall formulate and implement a program for rehabilitation and development that will address the needs of Moro-Islamic Liberation Front/ Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Force members and its decommissioned women auxiliary force, Moro National Liberation Front/Bangsamoro Armed Forces members, and address the needs of internally displaced persons, widows and orphans, and poverty-stricken communities. It shall observe, promote, and ensure gender-responsiveness in all aspects of security and peacebuilding, including the participation of women in decision-making;

**WHEREAS**, the implementation of the CTP and CTIP by both the national government and the Bangsamoro government will initiate the processes of transitioning from conflict-habituated systems to productive peace systems of major camps in the Bangsamoro Region;

**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BTA PARLIAMENT**, as it is hereby resolved, to urge the Government of the Day (GOTD) to support the implementation of the Camps Transformation Plan (CTP) and its accompanying

Camps Transformation Investment Plan (CTIP) advance post-conflict rehabilitation and transformation in the Bangsamoro region.
