A RESOLUTION URGING THE PARLIAMENT TO CREATE/IDENTIFY THE APPROPRIATE COMMITTEE THAT WILL DELIBERATE THE BTA BILL NO. 10 ENTITLED AN ACT FOR THE CREATION OF AN OFFICE FOR SETTLER COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 15 of Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao states that "The Bangsamoro Government shall ensure that settlers enjoy the rights guaranteed in this Organic Law. For this purpose, the Parliament shall create an office for Settler Communities to promote the welfare and address issues and concerns of settlers in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region."

WHEREAS, the Bangsamoro Organic Law promotes social justice and general welfare through the provision on Article IV, Section 7 which provides that "The Bangsamoro Government shall ensure every Filipino citizen in its territorial jurisdiction the provision of the basic necessities and equal opportunities in life. Social Justice shall be promoted in all aspects of life and phases of development in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region".

WHEREAS, the Parliament through its regular session conducted last July 29-31, 2019 already undergone the first reading of the BTA Bill No. 10 and is now submitted for the Committee deliberations.

WHEREAS, the proper committee that will handle the deliberations of the aforementioned BTA Bill was not yet determined or is not yet created.

BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Parliament shall endeavour to determine, identify or activate the proper committee that has jurisdiction in carrying out the deliberations on the BTA Bill No. 10
