A RESOLUTION
REQUESTING THE EIGHTEENTH CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF A P100 MILLION FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BANGSAMORO PARLIAMENT BUILDING

WHEREAS, Sec. 2, Art. VII of Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as the "Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao" reads:

Section 2. **Powers of Government.** The powers of government shall be vested in the Parliament which shall exercise those powers and functions expressly granted to it in this Organic Law, and those necessary for, or incidental to, the proper governance and development of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. It shall set policies, legislate on matters within its authority, and elect a Chief Minister who shall exercise executive authority on its behalf.

WHEREAS, eighty (80) Bangsamoro Transition Authority members took their oath before the President Rodrigo Duterte on February 22, 2019;

WHEREAS, considering the need to have a working and functional parliament, the 80 representatives of the Bangsamoro constituency need a space where meaningful legislations can be formulated and debated;

WHEREAS, this is an important symbol to represent the strength and authority of the Bangsamoro Government, and the power of the sovereign. It is crucial to have a functional parliament to stand as a testament to the spirit of a new Bangsamoro Government and the Bangsamoro People, and their hope for a bright future;
