## RESOLUTION CALLING FOR APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS AND DEVELOPMENT OF INTER-GOVERNMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR THE SUPPORT OF VARIOUS LIVELIHOOD PROJECTS

Resolution No. 94

Whereas, four out of top 5 poorest regions in the Philippines released in Family Income and Expenditure Survey (FIES) in 2015 by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM), now Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), is one of the registered in poverty incidence;

**Whereas,** the statistics showed that ARMM or BARMM is the poorest region with at least 59% of its population living below the poverty threshold;

Whereas, Section 2, Article 4 of the Republic Act 11054, also known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law, states that in the exercise of its right to self-governance, the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region is free to pursue its political, economic, social, and cultural development as provided for in this Organic Law.

Whereas, Section 7, Article 4 of the Republic Act 11054, states that the Bangsamoro Government shall ensure every Filipino citizen in its territorial jurisdiction the provision of the basic necessities and equal opportunities in life. Social justice shall be promoted in all aspects of life and phases of development in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region.

**Whereas,** Paragraph a, Section 5, Article 7 of the Republic Act 11054, provides that the parliament may enact laws to promote, protect and ensure the general welfare of the Bangsamoro people and other inhabitants in the BARMM;

**Whereas,** Section 8, Article 9 of the Republic Act 11054, provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall maintain, provide and ensure social justice, including the livelihood opportunities, to the inhabitants of the BARMM;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** as it is hereby resolved, that the Bangsamoro Government should allocate sufficient funds for the support of various livelihood projects to improve the socio-economic conditions of the inhabitants of the BARMM.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, as it is hereby further resolved, urging the Bangsamoro Government Ministries to develop inter-governmental guidelines that will provide, among others, the streamlined processes for the availment of the livelihood projects, unified records of beneficiaries and benefactors, and implementation and assessment methods.
