**RESOLUTION**

**CALLING ON THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE BASIC HOUSEHOLD TOOLS TO THE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs) OF MARAWI CITY PARTICULARLY THOSE RESIDING IN (MAA) SECTORS (1 - 4)**

**WHEREAS**, the Marawi Siege caused the displacement of 84,086 families or 388,073 individuals;

**WHEREAS**, the (24) Barangays in Marawi City which was heavily affected by the siege were clustered into nine (9) sectors;

**WHEREAS**, four (4) years after Marawi Siege, IDPs from the (24) barangays located in the Most Affected Area are still staying from different temporary shelters and home-based communities;

**WHEREAS**, this year marks the permanent return or "*kambalingan*" of some of the Marawi IDPs to their respective Barangays in the Most Affected Area (MAA) of Marawi City;

**WHEREAS**, the residents coming from the sector 1-4 of the most affected area were given permission to rebuild their houses provided that they comply with the requirements provided by the officials of the LGU-Marawi;

**WHEREAS**, during the return or "*kambalingan*" of the IDPs from the least affected area (72 Barangays) of Marawi City last 2018, Department of Social Welfare and Development

(DSWD) distributed to the returnee family food packs, hygiene kits, kitchen kits and financial assistance worth 5,000 pesos;

**WHEREAS**, providing basic tools and equipment to the IDPs who are allowed to rebuild their houses will complement the efforts of the Marawi Rehabilitation Program (MRP-PSC) which is eyeing to provide construction materials to the IDPs.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority:

**TO CALL ON THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE BASIC HOUSEHOLD TOOLS TO THE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs) OF MARAWI CITY PARTICULARLY THOSE RESIDING IN (MAA) SECTORS (1 - 4)**
