**RESOLUTION NO. 215**

**RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING TWENTY-FOUR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS OF THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (BARMM) FOR QUALIFYING AS MOST COMPETITIVE LGUS OF THE REGION IN THE 2021 CITIES AND MUNICIPALITIES, COMPETITIVENESS INDEX OF THE NATIONAL COMPETITIVENESS COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, the Cities and Municipalities Competitiveness Index is an annual ranking developed by the National Competitiveness Council through the Regional Competitiveness Committees with the assistance of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID);

**WHEREAS**, the main objective of the same is to promote local competitiveness to enhance long-term national competitiveness;

**WHEREAS**, cities and municipalities are ranked on their competitiveness based on the overall competitiveness score which is the sum of the scores of the four main pillars which pool data from several sub-indicators. The four main pillars are economic dynamism, government efficiency, infrastructure, and resiliency;

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, To forward the foregoing Resolution to the above-mentioned qualifying LGUs, for information.


