28	SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy – In the exercise of its right to self-governance, the

30	Bangsamoro Autonomous Region is free to pursue its political, economic, social, and cultural
31	development. It has the power to create offices and organize its own bureaucracy to ensure
32	efficient and effective delivery of government programs and services.

SECTION 3. Exclusion of the Bangsamoro Government Center from the control of the Local Government Unit. - Pursuant to the power of the Parliament to create, divide, merge, abolish or substantially alter boundaries of municipalities or barangays within the autonomous region, it is hereby declared that the location of the Bangsamoro Government Center within the Municipality of Parang is autonomous from the local government unit and will be directly

under the control and supervision of the regional government. To ensure smooth transition, consultations and dialogues with the local government units concerned and other stakeholders shall be conducted.

SECTION 4. Preparations. - The Bangsamoro government, through a Committee, shall immediately take action towards the development and implementation of masterplans, strategies and timetables that will provide the framework for the development of the Municipality of Parang as the new administrative center of the Bangsamoro government.

 SECTION 5. Committee on the Establishment of Administrative Capital (CEAC). – There is hereby established a Committee on the Establishment of Administrative Capital (CEAC), chaired by the Senior Minister and composed of four (4) other members, namely: the Minister of Finance, Budget and Management; the Minister of Public Works; the Minister of Environment, Natural Resources and Energy; and the Director-General of the Bangsamoro Planning and Development Office.

The Committee shall lead and organize the preparation, development and implementation of masterplans, strategies, processes and timetable that will provide the framework towards the development of the Municipality of Parang as the new administrative center of the Bangsamoro government;

The Committee shall immediately convene upon approval of this Act and shall cease to exist upon completion and full implementation of the objectives of this Act, which shall not exceed ten (10) years unless further extended by the Parliament.

SECTION 6. Appropriations. - The funds necessary to carry out the implementation of this Act shall be charged against the annual appropriations of the Bangsamoro Government.

SECTION 7. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Committee, in consultation with appropriate government agencies and other stakeholders, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations and other issuances as may be necessary to ensure the effective implementation of this Act.

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid.

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, executive orders, administrative orders, proclamations, rules and regulations, and issuances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
