Assalamualaikum!

I am Hashemi, a doctor and a public health worker. I began my career in public service as a Municipal Health Officer of Northern Kabuntalan, the smallest municipality in Maguindanao province. Serving as a community doctor has broadened my perspective. In a sense, it has been self-awakening to personally witness the predicament of our Bangsamoro brothers and sisters as well as the challenges they face in their daily lives.

Along with this, I was able to observe gaps in our healthcare. In particular, it allowed me to know firsthand the difficulties hurdled by our fellow health workers as they do their share in the delivery of healthcare services. Evidently, something could and should be done if we are to better our healthcare. This shaped my resolve and commitment to pursue a career path dedicated to public service.

In 2022, I was fortunate to be afforded the opportunity to carry on with my public service as one of the Members of Parliament of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority. This is a new pivot in my career as it calls for a different set of skills and expertise in a dynamic environment. But, at the same time, it will enable me to advance my advocacies as a public health worker.

Upon taking my oath of office, together with my newly formed team, we undertook to focus on three main agenda, namely, Health, Nutrition and Disaster Preparedness, or HND for short. We believe that these are enabling foundations to achieve progress and just and lasting peace in the Bangsamoro region.

The first four months of service was not an easy feat especially for a novice lawmaker. Notwithstanding the new journey, we have our share of modest accomplishments. Certainly, we could have not done it solely. We acknowledge the trust that our stakeholders have bestowed upon me, our office and our team. This proved to be invaluable in realizing our milestones.

In advocacy of improving the healthcare service in the BARMM, and as part of our accomplishments, we have proposed a twin motion to increase the honorarium of our barangay health workers (BHW) and increase the BHW workforce in the region which were both unanimously approved. Our BHWs will now receive P2,000 honorarium and 2,600 more BHWs will be deployed in the BARMM.

Moreover, we proposed the inclusion of four (4) additional hospitals under the Ayudang Medikal Mula sa Bangsamoro Government (AMBaG). With this, Bangsamoro patients confined at the South Cotabato Provincial Hospital, National Kidney Transplant Institute, Philippine Heart Center and Northern Mindanao Medical Center may now avail of medical assistance under the said program.

We have also filed a bill creating a hospital in Northern Kabuntalan. If approved, our brothers and sisters in the said municipality will no longer need to travel to neighboring municipalities for hospital care.

At the height of Tropical Storm Paeng, our office initiated relief operation efforts. Immediate assistance was extended to our fellow Bangsamoro who were unfortunately affected by TS Paeng.

And alongside, we have conducted dialogues and consultations with various stakeholders in the region. Likewise, community outreach programs were undertaken.

Needless to say, everything could have not been possible if Allah has not willed it. Alhamdulillah! Our gratitude also goes to those who, in one way or another, paved the way for us to be of service to the Bangsamoro people. Indeed, your trust reminds us to be steadfast in our commitment to live up to your expectations, Insha Allah.

May Allah bless always the Bangsamoro.
