CONGRATULATING THE PARTICIPANTS FROM THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (BARMM) IN THE 2022 SMART/MVP SPORTS FOUNDATION NATIONAL INTERSCHOOL TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR BRINGING HOME TWENTY (20) NATIONAL MEDALS TO THE REGION

WHEREAS, it is the Bangsamoro Government's policy to promote physical education program and encourage sports program, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for regional, national and international competitions, to foster discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, about two thousand students from school affiliated with the PTA all over the country participated in the biggest school-based tournament in the country;³

WHEREAS, students from ten (10) different schools in BARMM trained by the Heart of the Champion (HOTC) Team won twenty (20) medals in the said national taekwondo competition;

WHEREAS, the team bagged six (6) gold medals, two (2) silver, and twelve (12) bronze;
