**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SINCERE APPRECIATION AND GRATITUDE  
TO SENATOR ROBINHOOD "ROBIN" PADILLA FOR PROVIDING DISASTER  
RELIEF AND ASSISTANCE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE BANGSAMORO WHO  
SUFFERED CATASTROPHIC DAMAGE CAUSED BY SEVERE TROPICAL  
STORM PAENG**

**WHEREAS**, on October 26, 2022, a severe tropical storm known as Paeng (international name: Nalgae) hit the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), resulting in significant destruction, loss of life, and damage to agriculture and critical infrastructure due to flooding, sea surge, and landslides.

**WHEREAS**, according to the Bangsamoro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (BDRRMC), Severe Tropical Storm Paeng affected at least 570,285 individuals in the region, with 53 fatalities, 12 missing persons, and 38 injured persons.

**WHEREAS**, Severe Tropical Storm Paeng damaged 371 houses and partially damaged 480 others in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM). The storm also caused significant damage to infrastructure and agriculture, with estimated losses of around PHP 585,602,426.33;

57 **WHEREAS**, on 29 October 2022, Bangsamoro Chief Minister Ahod Ebrahim  
58 declared a state of calamity in the Bangsamoro Region due to the widespread  
59 damage and destruction brought about by Severe Tropical Storm Paeng;

61 **WHEREAS**, due to the complete devastation caused by Severe Tropical Storm  
62 Paeng, many people were left without access to basic supplies, including food,  
63 clean drinking water, and medical equipment. This necessitated urgent  
64 assistance and response efforts, including the procurement, transportation, and  
65 distribution of emergency relief commodities for the affected population.;

67 **WHEREAS**, on 5 November 2022 Senator Robinhood "Robin" Padilla and Senator  
68 Christopher "Bong" Go visited the Bangsamoro Region to provide much-needed  
69 disaster relief, in the form of basic necessities, relief packs and cash.

71 **WHEREAS**, The Senator showed his support and solidarity with the people of  
72 the Bangsamoro who are suffering from the effects of the calamity by giving  
73 uplifting speeches and interacting with them;  
74

75 **WHEREAS**, Senator Robinhood "Robin" Padilla played a significant role in  
76 making sure that basic goods and relief supplies reached the people of the  
77 Bangsamoro region who were affected by the disaster; his proactive approach  
78 and compassion were instrumental in providing much-needed assistance to  
79 those in need;

81 **NOW THEREFORE**, be it

83 **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority,  
84 the Bangsamoro extends its heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to Senator  
85 Robinhood "Robin" Padilla for his quick response and assistance in the disaster  
86 relief efforts.
