**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SINCERE APPRECIATION AND  
GRATITUDE OF THE BANGSAMORO TO VICE- PRESIDENT SARA "INDAY  
SARA" DUTERTE-CARPIO FOR PROVIDING DISASTER RELIEF AND  
ASSISTANCE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE BANGSAMORO WHO SUFFERED  
CATASTROPHIC DAMAGE CAUSED BY SEVERE TROPICAL STORM PAENG**

**WHEREAS**, on October 26, 2022, a severe tropical storm known as Paeng (international name: Nalgae) hit the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), resulting in significant destruction, loss of life, and damage to agriculture and critical infrastructure due to flooding, sea surge, and landslides.

**WHEREAS**, according to the Bangsamoro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (BDRRMC), Severe Tropical Storm Paeng affected at least 570,285 individuals in the region, with 53 fatalities, 12 missing persons, and 38 injured persons.

**WHEREAS**, Severe Tropical Storm Paeng damaged 371 houses and partially damaged 480 others in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM). The storm also caused significant damage to infrastructure and agriculture, with estimated losses of around PHP 585,602,426.33;

56 **WHEREAS**, on 29 October 2022, Bangsamoro Chief Minister Ahod Ebrahim  
57 declared a state of calamity in the Bangsamoro Region due to the widespread  
58 damage and destruction brought about by Severe Tropical Storm Paeng;

60 **WHEREAS**, due to the complete devastation caused by Severe Tropical Storm  
61 Paeng, many people were left without access to basic supplies, including food,  
62 clean drinking water, and medical equipment. This necessitated urgent  
63 assistance and response efforts, including the procurement, transportation, and  
64 distribution of emergency relief commodities for the affected population.;

66 **WHEREAS**, Vice-President Sara Duterte-Carpio, through the Office of the Vice-  
67 President (OVP) as part of a disaster relief initiative to the communities affected  
68 by Severe Tropical Storm Paeng was able to provide assistance to 500 families in  
69 Datu Odin, Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte, as well as other parts of the  
70 Bangsamoro Region;

72 **WHEREAS**, to alleviate the suffering of the people of the Bangsamoro, the Vice-  
73 President expressed her solidarity with the calamity-stricken families and  
74 signified to supporting a recovery plan for victims of Severe Tropical Storm  
75 Paeng;

77 **WHEREAS**, Vice-President Sara Duterte-Carpio played a significant role in  
78 making sure that basic goods and relief supplies reached the people of the  
79 Bangsamoro region who were affected by the disaster; her proactive approach  
80 and compassion were instrumental in providing much-needed assistance to  
81 those in need;

83 **NOW THEREFORE**, be it

85 **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority,  
86 the Bangsamoro extends its heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to Vice-  
87 President Sara Duterte-Carpio for her quick response and assistance in the  
88 disaster relief efforts.
