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18 **A RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DAY TO**
19 **CONSTITUTE AND OPERATIONALIZE THE COUNCIL OF LEADERS**
20 **PURSUANT TO SECTION 9, ARTICLE VI OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11054**
21 **AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF.**

24 **WHEREAS**, the Council of Leaders is a focused group who fulfill a
25 number of special functions which includes but not limited to promoting the
26 right of the represented to participate in the crafting of policies that involve
27 their interest and welfare, and serve as visible advocates by effectively
28 articulating concerns and address issues of the community they are
29 representing.

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31 **WHEREAS**, their primary role is to provide guidance and assistance in
32 identification of pertinent necessities for the development and growth, and
33 possible solicitation of ideas to attain common goal while simultaneously
34 enhancing the image and advancement of the community.

35
36 **WHEREAS**, Section 9, Article VI of Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise
37 known as Bangsamoro Organic Law on Council of Leaders reads:

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39 There shall be a Council of Leaders that shall advise the
40 Chief Minister on matters of governance in the Bangsamoro
41 Autonomous Region. It shall consist of the following members:
42

- 43 a) Chief Minister as head of the council;
44 b) Members of the Congress of the Philippines from the
45 Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;
46 c) Provincial governors, and mayors of chartered cities in
47 the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;
48 d) Representatives of traditional leaders, non-Moro
49 indigenous communities, women, settler communities,
50 the *Ulama*, youth, and Bangsamoro communities outside
51 of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region; and
52 e) Representatives of other sectors.

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54 The mechanism of representation and number of
55 representatives in paragraphs (d) and (e) shall be determined
56 by the Parliament. The representation of the non-Moro
57 indigenous communities shall be pursuant to their
58 customary laws and indigenous processes.
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60 **WHEREAS**, consistent with the above cited provision, under Book II
61 Intergovernmental Relations of Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13, otherwise
62 known as Bangsamoro Administrative Code eloquently detailed the important
63 participation of Council of Leaders to coordinate and resolve issues on
64 intergovernmental relations through regular consultation and continuing
65 negotiation in a non-adversarial manner. ¹

67 **WHEREAS**, this Proposed Resolution aim to aid the BARMM Parliament
68 in formulating policies relevant to the community represented by the Council
69 of Leaders; coordinate, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the
70 policies, plans, and programs to ascertain the equality of opportunities
71 accorded to them; and to ensure full participation of the minorities in the
72 legislation as guaranteed by the statutory law provided in the Bangsamoro
73 Organic Law.

75 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved by the
76 Bangsamoro Parliament of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim
77 Mindanao in **A RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DAY**
78 **TO CONSTITUTE AND OPERATIONALIZE THE COUNCIL OF LEADERS**
79 **PURSUANT TO SECTION 9, ARTICLE VI OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11054**
80 **AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF.**
