**“AN ACT TO UPGRADE THE EXISTING DATU ODIN SINSUAT DISTRICT
HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DATU ODIN SINSUAT, PROVINCE OF
MAGUINDANAO FROM ITS PRESENT STATUS WITH A FIFTY (50) BED
CAPACITY INTO ONE HUNDRED (100) BED CAPACITY, ITS FACILITIES
AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE, AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF
ITS MEDICAL PERSONNEL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES”**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The creation of this Proposed BTA Parliament bill is in furtherance of timely appropriation, comprehensive implementation and full compliance of the adopted Republic Act No. 11330 entitled “ AN ACT CONVERTING THE DINAIG MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DATU ODIN SINSUAT PROVINCE OF MAGUINDANAO, INTO A FIFTY (50) BED CAPACITY DISTRICT HOSPITAL TO BE KNOWN AS THE DATU ODIN SINSUAT DISTRICT HOSPITAL, UPGRADING ITS FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE, AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF ITS MEDICAL PERSONNEL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR” signed and approved by no less than the President of the Philippines, Rodrigo Roa Duterte on April 2019.

Upon inquiry with the hospital’s Officer in charge - Chief Nurse, Laboratory Supervisor, Housekeeping Supervisor and Admin Assistant as of the year 2022, it was found out that, even though the hospital has indeed

45 implemented the 50-bed capacity required by Republic Act 11330, the funds that
46 were appropriated and transferred to the abovementioned hospital were only for
47 that of a 10-bed capacity budget since its adoption. Needless to say, therefore,
48 that other requirements that need serious attention and urgent compliance such
49 as the pertinent facilities, equipment, additional professional medical staff and
50 increase in medical personnel which are imperative for the proper operation of
51 the hospital are not complied with. With the outnumbered professional medical
52 staff and medical personnel, patients are deemed deprived of their right to proper
53 medical attention and intervention for quick response to their recovery and
54 recuperation. The lives of the patients are in apparent peril and jeopardy for the
55 obvious reason. Another dilemma of the hospital is the uncomplimentary
56 structure of its building to cater 50-bed capacity. It is worth mentioning that the
57 structure of the hospital was built for level-1 status or only for 10-bed capacity
58 thus, this Proposed BTA Parliament Bill also intends to include appropriation of
59 funds for the construction and renovation of the said hospital for its expansion
60 into a one hundred (100) bed capacity.

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62 Among nearby municipalities in Maguindanao, statistical records would
63 show that the highest population became the impetus and the assessment of the
64 need for the rising of the Datu Odin Sinsuat (DOS) District Hospital. Since then,
65 the hospital has become the referring unit, a detachment from the nearby
66 municipalities, and from time to time catered a wide number of cases and
67 patients from different nearby municipalities. Furthermore, prior to COVID-19
68 pandemic, DOS District Hospital catered more than the 50-bed capacity limit;
69 we can only imagine the patients crowding in the lobby of the hospital with their
70 watchers sleeping on the floor.

72 In Section 2 paragraph 2 of Article IX of R.A. 11054 otherwise known as
73 the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao,
74 "the Bangsamoro Government shall protect and promote the right to health of
75 the people and instill health consciousness among them. It shall also uphold the
76 peoples' right to have access to essential goods, health, and other social services
77 that promote their well-being. The Parliament shall enact appropriate legislation
78 towards this end.

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80 The Bangsamoro Government is mandated to create and implement
81 legislation that would benefit the Bangsamoro People and the general Public.
82 Thus, this proposed BTA Parliament bill for the expansion of the DOS District
83 Hospital into 100-bed capacity.

20 *Be it enacted by Bangsamoro Transition Authority in Parliament assembled:*

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22 **SEC. 1. Title.** – This Act shall be known as the **“UPGRADING DATU ODIN**
23 **SINSUAT DISTRICT HOSPITAL 2023”**

25 **SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy.** – It is a policy of the Bangsamoro Autonomous
26 Region in Muslim Mindanao as provided under Section 22, Article IX of the
27 Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the “Organic Law of the Bangsamoro
28 Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao” to provide for a comprehensive and
29 integrated health service delivery for its constituents and establish by law a
30 general hospital system to serve the health requirements of its people and ensure
31 that the individual basic right to life shall be attainable through the prompt
32 intervention of excellence and affordable medical services.
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34 **SEC. 3. To upgrade the existing Datu Odin Sinsuat District Hospital.** – The
35 existing Datu Odin Sinsuat District Hospital is hereby upgraded from its present
36 status with a fifty (50) bed capacity into one hundred (100) Authorized Bed
37 Capacity in accordance with the national standards set by the Bureau of Health
38 Facilities and Services under the Department of Health (DOH). The existing
39 building including its landscaping, medical and office equipment and other
40 facilities, its operating funds and personnel are also hereby upgraded to include
41 the needed construction and procurement thereof in order to meet the
42 prescribed standards commensurate to the upgraded level.

44 **SEC. 4. Integration of the Universal Health Care (UHC) Program.** –To
45 upgrade the existing Datu Odin Sinsuat District Hospital, it shall integrate into
46 its system of operations all the pertinent and relevant provisions under Republic
47 Act No. 11223 otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act.
48

49 **SEC. 5. Administration, Management, and Organization.** – The Datu Odin
50 Sinsuat District Hospital shall be under the administrative supervision of the
51 Minister of Health who is hereby authorized to determine and approve the
52 appropriate organizational structure for the management and operations of the
53 facility, and if necessary, shall cause the creation of the Hospital Board of
54 Directors, define its powers and functions, and appoint its officers and members,
55 in accordance with existing laws.

57 **SEC. 6. Appropriation.** – The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of
58 this Act shall be included in the Bangsamoro Appropriations Act. Thereafter,
59 funds necessary for the maintenance and operation of the hospital shall be
60 provided in accordance with the provisions of the Bangsamoro Appropriations
61 Act and other pertinent laws.
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63 **SEC. 7. Implementing Rules and Regulations.** – The Bangsamoro
64 Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao – Ministry of Health (BARMM-MOH)
65 shall promulgate the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of this Act
66 within sixty (60) days after the enactment of this act.
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68 **SEC. 8. Separability Clause.** – In the event any provision of this act or the
69 application of such provision is declared invalid, the remainder of this act shall
70 not be affected by such declaration and shall remain in full force and effect.
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72 **SEC. 9. Repealing Clause.** – All laws and regulations under the Bangsamoro
73 Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) government including those
74 passed under the defunct Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM)
75 government regarding the operations of the Datu Odin Sinsuat District Hospital
76 not consistent with this Act are hereby repealed.

77 **SEC. 10. Effectivity.** – This Act shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following
78 the completion of its publication in a newspaper of regional circulation in the
79 Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.
