The proposed resolution was filed last September 03, 2022 at the Office of Secretary General. It was discussed in the plenary session last September 17, 2022 and on the same date the said resolution was referred to the committee. Immediately, the committee conducted its 2nd committee meeting on March 02, 2023 to discuss the proposed resolution.

The Chairperson opened the discussion on the referred resolution and emphasize that for it is within the power of the Supreme Court to do so. Other members of the committee also emphasized that integration will affect the Shari'ah Counselors as an integrated body, a collective voice within the judicial system.

Then finally, concluded, that there is merit to the resolution, later unanimously approved the submission of the aforecited resolution to the Parliament for its consideration and approval.
