42 **WHEREAS**, during the state visit in the Philippines of Malaysian Prime
43 Minister Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim on March 1, 2023 at Malacañang, Manila, he
44 expressed his commitment to continue their role in supporting the Bangsamoro
45 Peace Process in pursuit of attaining lasting peace and development in
46 Mindanao. He also stated that his government will provide assistance through
47 various capacity-building programs to "former fighters so they can be involved
48 in normal employment, which in the long run will contribute to long lasting
49 peace";

51 **WHEREAS**, the Malaysian Prime Minister subsequently met the
52 Bangsamoro Chief Minister Ahod Ebrahim and had a telephone conversation
53 with MNLF Founding Chairman Prof. Nur P. Misuari and discussed the
54 assurances about cooperation so that reconciliation, especially among Muslims

1 in the south of the Philippines, can be well established to ensure success of
2 thousands of former fighters under the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and
3 the Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF);

5 **WHEREAS**, the Malaysian Prime Minister expressed that Malaysia has
6 the "responsibility as a neighboring country, a Muslim country as well, to ensure
7 that there is meaningful success and lasting peace in southern Philippines;

9 **WHEREAS**, the Malaysian Prime Minister expressed profound thanks and
10 gratitude to His Excellency President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. for taking great
11 strides "On the peace process in Mindanao" and further expressed that "It is only
12 our duty, as a good neighbor, to support and facilitate the process,";

14 **WHEREAS**, the concern of the Malaysia Prime Minister for the Muslims
15 in Southern Philippines exemplifies his adherence to the message of Prophet
16 Muhammad, the Messenger of Allah ﷺ who said "The parable of the believers in
17 their affection, mercy, and compassion for each other is that of a body. When
18 any limb aches, the whole body reacts with sleeplessness and fever".

20 **NOW THEFEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,**
21 that the Bangsamoro Transition Authority Parliament, convey its gratitude and
22 thanks to Malaysian Prime Minister Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim for expressing the
23 continuing concern and support of the Malaysian Government to the interest of
24 peace process in Southern Philippines to ensure success of the plight of the
25 Bangsamoro People for lasting peace and development in the Bangsamoro
26 Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao and in their homeland.
