**A RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ALNAKRAN ABDILLA, A
NATIVE OF TAWI-TAWI AND HIS TEAM FOR SECURING A BRONZE
MEDAL FOR MEN'S BEACH VOLLEYBALL IN THE 32ND SOUTHEAST
ASIAN GAMES IN PHNOM PENH, CAMBODIA, AND FOR GIVING
HONOR AND PRIDE TO THE BANGSAMORO REGION**

WHEREAS, on 5 May 2023, the 32nd Southeast Asian (SEA) Games held its opening ceremony hosted by Cambodia in its capital, Phnom Penh. This biennial multi-sports event is held from May 5 to 17, hosting a total of 584 games in 36 sports;

WHEREAS, the SEA Games is participated by eleven (11) Southeast Asian Nations: Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor-Leste, and Vietnam. Wherein, the Philippines debuted its participation in the year 1977;

WHEREAS, Alnakran "Ranran" Abdilla, hailing from the Province of Tawi-Tawi, and his team won against their Vietnamese rival in the men's beach volleyball competition on May 16, held in Otres Beach, Sihanoukville, Cambodia;

WHEREAS, securing the score of 2-0 game victories, the men's national team settled for a bronze medal, maintaining the position for a third consecutive time in the SEA Games. This bronze medal is the only medal obtained by the Philippines in the volleyball sport category;

WHEREAS, the Philippine men's team for the beach volleyball category is composed of athletes Abdilla, Jaron Requinton, James Buytrago, and Jude Garcia;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, to commend and congratulate Alnakran Abdilla, a native of Tawi-Tawi and his team for securing a bronze medal for men's beach volleyball in the 32nd Southeast Asian Games in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, and for giving honor and pride to the Bangsamoro region;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, directing the Bangsamoro Sports Commission to provide incentives and continued support for Abdilla's athletic career.
