RESOLUTION NO. 344

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SYMPATHY AND CONDOLENCES TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE PASTOR TROY ERIC O. CORDERO AND RECOGNIZING HIS ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT OF BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (BARMM) AS WELL AS HIS CONTRIBUTIONS AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SETTLER COMMUNITIES TO THE BANGSAMORO GOVERNMENT COUNCIL OF LEADERS

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2023, upon satisfactorily meeting the criteria for selection, Pastor Troy Eric Obrigoso Cordero was appointed by Chief Minister Ahod B. Ebrahim, Al-Haj, as a representative of Settler Communities to the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) Council of Leaders, pursuant to Section 9, Article VI, of Republic Act No. 11054 or the Bangsamoro Organic Law;

WHEREAS, as a *Cotabateño* since birth and an advocate of sustainable peace and development in BARMM, Pastor Troy Eric Obrigoso Cordero has passionately supported the passage of Bangsamoro Basic Law, now Republic Act No. 11054, during the campaign activities for its approval in the Philippine Congress;

WHEREAS, Pastor Troy, as the Chairperson of the Metro Cotabato and Suburbs Ministerial Fellowship, Inc., earnestly campaigned for the inclusion of Cotabato City in the BARMM region which resulted in a victory of YES votes during the plebiscite on January 21, 2019;

WHEREAS, Pastor Troy had been committed with his unrelenting support to attaining the lifelong dream of our right to self-determination as the Bangsamoro people;

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2023, Pastor Troy Eric Obrigoso Cordero departed as he was summoned and called by our Almighty Creator;

WHEREAS, the passing away of Pastor Cordero, a dedicated and passionate church leader, is a great loss not only to Christian communities but to the whole Bangsamoro people;

WHEREAS, his dedication and sacrifices in the furtherance of the welfare of the Bangsamoro people will be remembered with great honor and pride and will never be forgotten in our history as a Bangsamoro people:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, To express sympathy and condolences to the bereaved family of the late pastor Troy Eric O. Cordero and recognize his active participation in the peace and development of BARMM as well as his contributions as a representative of the settler communities to the Bangsamoro Government Council of Leaders.
